

# ART AND JOURNALISM BUILDING

The Art and Journalism Building, located in the heart of Ball State University's campus, represents the first time the University has housed its departments of Art and Journalism under one roof. A four-story atrium is the focal point of the building. To reflect the existing architecture on campus, the exterior design utilized red brick with glass and limestone curtainwall accents. The facility includes an art gallery, art studios, writing labs, classrooms, faculty offices, photography labs, and a food service area with dining space and campus bookstore. The building's design allocates specific space to each department while incorporating common areas for students and faculty to interact. A connector to the adjacent College of Communications incorporated into the new building's design fosters interaction between the art, journalism, and communications students and faculty.
