The renovation of the third, fourth, and fifth floors of Barnes & Thornburg consisted of an interiors build-out reflecting the unique functions located on each floor. The third floor contains the relocated, approximately 3,000 sq. ft. library. The fourth floor renovation was prompted by a need to locate technical and administrative functions on one floor. These spaces were designed on a limited budget, which reflected their utilitarian and practical nature. The fifth floor became the primary public floor and the Firm's "front door." It housed the main reception area, access to the parking garage, a conference center with its own reception and waiting area, training rooms, a cater / hostess facility, and attorney / visitor offices. The overall look of the floor and its corresponding detailing, palette, and finishes was appropriate to the upscale and public nature of the space, the culture of the firm, and otherwise provided an understated elegance.
