

U.S. FEDERAL COURTHOUSE RESTORATION

RATIO provided historic preservation services for the United States Courts located within the Heartland Region of the General Services Administration (GSA) through supplemental architect-engineer (A/E) contracts held by SFS Architecture in Kansas City, Missouri. One of those projects included the judge's chambers and woodwork restoration at the federal courthouse in Des Moines, Iowa.

The project team restored all of the building's wood window sills and wood handrails, and also restored the judge's quarters and adjacent library to their original design. The restoration included new light fixtures to replicate the original fixtures, an upgrade of the mechanical and electrical systems, the addition of a fire sprinkler system, and ceiling and woodwork restoration.
