

PRESIDENT BENJAMIN HARRISON HOME

The President Benjamin Harrison Home was built during 1874 and 1875. Significant additions were constructed circa 1888 and 1895. The property, located within the Old Northside Historic District of Indianapolis, has been designated as a National Historic Landmark. RATIO completed a restoration of the original wood windows and decorative metal cornice, as well as an exterior paint analysis to return the house to its 1895 appearance. Additional work included the sympathetic integration of a new mechanical system, the reconstruction of the carriage house for use as an interpretive feature, and caretaker living quarters. The construction of an exterior elevator shaft and installation of an interior residential elevator to make the building accessible to patrons with disabilities was completed in 2000. Recent work, funded through the Save America's Treasures grant program restored interior finishes throughout the house.
