

LIFELONG LEARNING CENTER

The Scott County Foundation's Board of Directors and the Austin Enterprise Community Strategic Plan envisioned the Lifelong Learning Center (LLLC) as a way to provide adults a continuum of learning opportunities, as well as other educational solutions, through career development. The underlying concept for the LLLC was to create a "one stop" service center for employment and family support services. Services provided include: adult education, rehabilitation services, all age literacy programs, family and parenting programs, job assessment and placement activities, and basic job skills training. The 9,000 sq. ft. building contains computer labs, flexible classrooms, conference/meeting rooms, distance learning center, and literacy and workforce development support offices. A flexible industrial training facility is located in a separate building adjacent to the main center.
