

# VETERINARY MEDICINE BASIC SCIENCE BUILDING

The renovations to the second and third floors house the Department of Veterinary Biosciences (molecular genetics and environmental toxicology) and the Department of Veterinary Pathobiology (infectious diseases). The laboratories are supported by environmental and radio isotope rooms, equipment storage spaces, private and open offices as well as conference and small teaching spaces. The laboratories were designed with the benefits of modular planning in mind. The utilities were also developed in this fashion to allow for future changes and retrofit of individual lab units without disruption to adjacent spaces.
